Prevail Bank Shred Event Helps Veterans in Crisis with \$2,075 Donation

(Baraboo) Turning paper into something powerful, Prevail Bank's Community Shred Day in Baraboo raised \$2,075 for People Helping People's Adopt a Veteran Program, supporting community heroes in need throughout the area.

Prevail Bank pledged to donate \$1 for every pound of paper shredded, up to \$1,000—and the community rose to the challenge, bringing in a 4,000 pounds of documents to be safely destroyed and recycled. True to its pledge, Prevail Bank gifted \$1,000; the public donated an additional \$1,075.
