Prevail Bank Shred Event Helps Ensure Every Child has Healthier Future with \$1,105 Donation

(Marshfield) Turning paper into something powerful, Prevail Bank's Community Shred Day in Marshfield raised \$1,105 for the <u>Children's Miracle</u> <u>Network</u>, helping to make sure every child receives the best possible medical care in the area.

Prevail Bank pledged to donate \$1 for every pound of paper shredded, up to



\$1,000—and the community rose to the challenge, bringing 1,968 pounds of documents to be safely destroyed and recycled. True to its pledge, Prevail Bank gifted \$1,000; the public donated an additional \$105.
