### Prevail Bank Shred Event Helps Medford VFW Post 5729

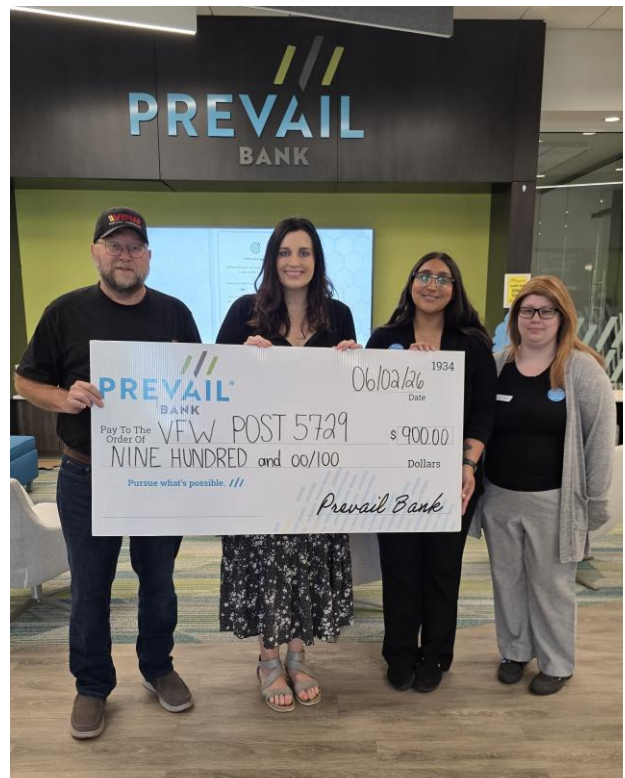
