Prevail Bank Shred Event Helps Veterans with \$622 Donation

(Medford) Turning paper into something powerful, Prevail Bank's Community Shred Day in Medford raised \$622 for Operation Horses Heal, a nonprofit that brings inclusive support to veterans, active service members, and their immediate families through equine-related activities.

Prevail Bank pledged to donate \$1 for every pound of paper shredded, up to \$1,000. The community brought 597 pounds of documents to be safely destroyed and recycled. True to its pledge, Prevail Bank gifted \$597; the public donated an additional \$25.
