Prevail Bank Shred Event Helps Friends of the Old School with \$1,131 Donation

(Owen) Turning paper into something powerful, Prevail Bank's Community Shred Day in Owen raised \$1,131 for <u>Friends of the Old</u> <u>School</u> (FOSI), a nonprofit historical society organized to promote local history and provide community programs.

Prevail Bank pledged to donate \$1 for every pound of paper shredded, up to \$1,000—and the community rose to the challenge, bringing in a 1,107 pounds of documents to be safely destroyed and recycled. True to its pledge, Prevail Bank gifted \$1,000; the public donated an additional \$131.
