\$2,000 gifted to Community Mission with Jesus by Prevail Bank



(Medford) Two-thousand-dollars (\$2,000) was awarded to the Community Mission With Jesus by Prevail Bank so it could provide short-term assistance to people in Taylor County who are facing challenges resulting from job loss, medical bills, and/or those waiting for disability benefits. The Mission, consisting of nine churches, also provides financial counseling for effective budgeting.

Twenty-nine (29) nonprofit organizations were selected to receive funding through Prevail Bank's Charitable Contributions program this spring; the Mission was one of them. The program awarded a total of \$82,500 to nonprofits that serve low-to-moderate income households, stimulate local economies, offer financial education, or work to improve the quality of life for underserved populations in the communities Prevail Bank serves.
