## Prevail Bank Supports Children's Imaginarium with a \$3,000 and a \$1,337 Donation

(Wausau) The Children's Imaginarium, an educational interactive museum, received \$3,000 from Prevail Bank in support of its STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) field trip fund.

This contribution was awarded through Prevail Bank's Charitable Contributions Committee.

The \$1,337 was the result of Prevail Bank's recent Community Shred Event. Prevail Bank pledged \$1, up to \$1,000, for every pound of paper brought to be shredded; and the community rose to the challenge, bringing in a whopping 5,000 pounds of paper to be safely destroyed and recycled! The public chipped in an additional \$337 in donations, bringing the total gift to \$1,337.
